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# COUNTING ETHNICITY AND RACE HARMONIZING RACE AND ETHNICITY DATA IN LATIN AMERICA

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## INTRODUCTION

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<sup>1</sup> This analysis specifically looks at the conditions of indigenous peoples and African descendants in countries with the most marginalized indigenous and African descendant populations, and where there is relevant data. This analysis focuses on measuring data availability and harmonizing ethno-racial variables across 19 Latin American and Caribbean countries. These are: Argentina, Belize, Bolivia, Brazil, Chile, Colombia, Costa Rica, the Dominican Republic, Ecuador, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Mexico, Nicaragua, Panama, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay, and Venezuela.

This document provides an inventory of available national census and household survey questions on race and ethnicity in Latin America <sup>1</sup> while sharing a methodology for harmonizing data on race and ethnicity across countries over time.<sup>2</sup> By contributing to the understanding of how to harmonize race and ethnicity variables, we hope to increase the pool of researchers who can use race and ethnicity data to undertake cross-country analysis that will inform development policy-making to reduce socio-economic gaps between indigenous peoples, African descendants, and the rest of the population.

## 2. Availability of Data

To create the most comprehensive inventory possible, we examined all Latin American census questionnaires since 2000 available through the United Nations Statistical Division.<sup>3</sup> For household surveys, we utilized the IDB's MECOVI<sup>4</sup> databank and the SEDLAC<sup>5</sup> database to identify household surveys for each country (See Annex 1). We then completed this information with questionnaires and files from each national statistical institute. We went through each questionnaire to flag questions used for defining ethno-racial groups in any form. Using this method, we located questions on race and ethnicity for 29 different censuses in 20 countries in the region and for 143 surveys in 14 countries. Most countries, with the exception of Argentina, the Dominican Republic, Honduras, Panama, and Venezuela, have some form of ethno-racial classification question in both their census and household survey (See Table 1). Argentina, Honduras, Panama, and Venezuela have classification questions in their censuses, but not in their surveys.

NOTES: \*More recent data that includes race and ethnicity data is available, but not through the national flagship household survey (See Annex 1). For information on these surveys, please refer to Annex2. \*\* Although data by race and ethnicity is available in the 2012 Chilean census, concerns over the methodology utilized in the implementation of the census led the Chilean government to void the results of the census.

Ethnicity is multidimensional and can be measured using a variety of concepts, including ethnic ancestry or origin, ethnic identity, cultural origins, nationality, race, color, minority status, language, religion or various combinations of these concepts. In Latin America, there are two main approaches that are utilized to ask about ethno-racial identity. One is to ask an individual's primary spoken language and the other is through self-identification.

Language questions were (and are still being) used by some of the first countries which started asking questions about race and ethnicity in the 1990s, namely Bolivia and Paraguay. In most cases, using language to define ethno-racial identity tends to underestimate the size of the indigenous population as not all individuals who are ethnically indigenous speak a traditional language. Urbanization and Spanish only language education has contributed to the loss of indigenous languages, especially among young people (Crystal, 2000). In 2009, according to UNICEF and FUNPROEIB Andes, more than a fifth of Latin American indigenous peoples do not speak an indigenous language; the World Bank (2015) reports that less than 31.9 percent of indigenous peoples that attend primary school speak an indigenous language by the time they complete their education. In Paraguay, the opposite often occurs, where the use of language may overestimate the indigenous population, because a large number of Paraguayans speak and understand the dominant indigenous language, Guarani, but neither self-identify as indigenous nor are direct descendants of indigenous peoples. Calculations done by the IDB using Paraguayan survey data from 2014 for spoken indigenous language show that indigenous language speakers represented about 32% of the total population, while the 2002 national census, which uses a self-identification question, indicated that the indigenous population was approximately 1.7%.<sup>6</sup>

Given these considerations, as well as the complex ways that individuals and ethno-racial groups may define themselves, most experts agree that the best approach to determine an individual's race or ethnicity is to ask him or her whether he/she considers him/herself to belong to a people (*pueblo*),<sup>7</sup> or a specific ethno-racial group based on relationship to territory, culture, belief, way of life, or ancestry. This is referred to as self-identification.

Self-identification has its own challenges.<sup>8</sup> The way an individual is asked to self-identify can impact the response. For example, it may not be the same for an individual to consider him or herself indigenous based on perception of a set of cultural or ethnic criteria as it is for an individual to "belong" to a specific indigenous *pueblo*, through a formal registry process or recognition by traditional authorities. Belonging ("pertenecer" in Spanish) may be considered more official and include certain privileges. As such, individuals may not consider themselves to be indigenous if they do not formally "belong" to a particular *pueblo*. This may result in underestimates of population numbers (see Box 1).

Another complication is that identities can be fluid. Individuals may consider themselves to have more than one identity at the same time or have different identities depending on the context. This is prevalent in Latin America due to the region's mixing of different ethno-racial groups (*mestizaje*). This can create situations where individuals would prefer to identify with more than one ethno-racial group. In the case of Uruguay, for example, the question has been adapted to recognize these multiple ethno-racial categories.<sup>9</sup> Identity can also change depending on the context or on the identity of the person asking the question. For instance, individuals can consider themselves indigenous when surrounded

In 1998, Afro-Ecuadorians were officially recognized in the National Constitution as a *pueblo* or culturally and politically distinct peoples.

individuals from other races/ethnicities, but not indigenous enough when in the company of other indigenous peoples. Additionally, there are challenges to using self-identification for measuring discrimination as discrimination is typically based on how others see an individual rather than on self-perception. Consequently, innovative ways of determining racial and ethnic identity in surveys are being explored (see Box 2).

Since 2000, self-identification has been used by 20 Latin American countries to determine ethno-racial identity in national censuses. After 2000, 13 countries in the region began to include questions on ethno-racial identity in household surveys. Brazil, Bolivia and Paraguay, have included these questions since 1990. These early adopters of questions on ethno-racial identity started with language-based questions and later moved to self-identification. Only Paraguay and Mexico continue using spoken language as their primary means of determining ethno-racial identity (see Table 2). Despite these important exceptions, due to the significant differences in indigenous population statistics explained above, we recommend researchers refrain from using language for determining ethno-racial identity whenever possible. As there is no source of information based on self-identification for Paraguay, we recommend that researchers refer either to the 2002 census or the 2012 Indigenous Peoples Census (Dirección General de Estadística, Encuestas y Censos, 2013) for their analyses (Table 2).

Also note that Chile,<sup>10</sup> Mexico,<sup>11</sup> and Paraguay do not include the option to self-identify as African descendant in their questions, making it impossible to calculate the share of the population that self-identifies as African descendant in these countries using official data. Guatemala and Nicaragua included the African descendant category in their censuses, but do not do so in their household surveys. This reduces the amount of policy relevant information available on African descendants in these countries.

## Box 1

### Indigenous Peoples in Chile and Bolivia: Declining Populations?

Some recent censuses in Latin America reveal a surprising trend: indigenous peoples are disappearing. However, they are not dying, or leaving their countries. Instead, individuals who had self identified as indigenous earlier have opted to no longer identify as indigenous. Countries like Chile and Bolivia are good examples. In 1992, the Chilean Census reported that 10.3% of the population was indigenous. However, in the 2002 census it was a mere 4.6%. Similarly, in 2001 the Bolivian census yielded an indigenous population of 62% that dropped to 40.3% in 2012.

The changes in the number of individuals self-identifying as indigenous may be due to many factors, including indigenous peoples migrating to urban centers, and the changing definition of who is indigenous. While some of these factors are outside the control of the government, the examples of Chile and Bolivia highlight challenges facing individual self-identification and how governments can influence individuals based on the wording of the question.

In the case of Chile, the census question may have impacted how individuals self-identified by race and ethnicity. In 1992, individuals were asked “If you are Chilean, do you consider yourself a member of one of the following cultures?” This question was sufficiently broad, particularly given that an individual may identify with a culture even if they do not belong to a specific indigenous group.

In 2002, the indigenous self identification question was reworded as “Do you belong to one of the following indigenous or original pueblos (peoples)?” The decline in the portion of the population self-identifying as indigenous may be, at least in part, due to this more restricted definition. Asking only if individuals belonged to a specific pueblo, may have led indigenous descendants to feel that they could no longer identify themselves as indigenous, if they did not have a link to a particular territory or indigenous peoples (such as Mapuche or Aymara).

For the 2012 Bolivian census, the government broadened the census question related to indigenous identity to include 40 different groups (including Afro Bolivians). The Bolivian media reported this change as an omission of the mestizo category from the census, even though “mestizo” had never been an option in the national census. The resulting politicization of indigenous identity may have led ethnically indigenous individuals to choose not to self-identify as indigenous even if they previously had done so before.

Self-identification is still considered the gold standard for ethno-racial definition, but results should be analyzed contextually. As the cases of Chile and Bolivia reveal, identity can be fluid, with identity being determined at least in part by the phrasing of the question or the political conditions surrounding the census.

## Box 2

### Evolving Identification of Race and Ethnicity: Mexico

Mexico's flagship national survey, Encuesta Nacional de Ingresos y Gastos en Hogares (ENIGH), has included a question on self-identification exclusively for indigenous origin since 2010. However, the Mexican government still uses indigenous language as its primary means for ethno-racial identification.

The Encuesta Intercensal 2015 survey piloted a self-identification question for both indigenous people and Afro-descendants along with the standard language questions. The results indicated that while only 6.5% of the population speaks an indigenous language, 21.5% considers themselves to be of indigenous origin. Furthermore, the survey showed 1.2% of the Mexican population (approximately 1.4 million people) consider themselves to have African heritage.

In June 2017 Mexico's National Institute of Statistics (INEGI) published the "Modulo de Movilidad Social Intergeneracional 2016" (MMSI), as a supplement to the National Household Survey (ENH). Unlike previous versions of the ENH or the ENIGH, the MMSI includes self-identification questions on both race and skin color. The skin color is assessed using a color scale palette based on the work of the Project on Ethnicity and Race in Latin America (PERLA) at Princeton University\*.

The MMSI is a groundbreaking survey, as it includes retrospective questions which allow for analysis of the race- and skin color-disaggregated trends in social mobility, defined as the intergenerational transmission of socio-economic status, allowing for a better understanding of how these characteristics relate to access to economic opportunities and inequality.

## **3. Harmonizing Race and Ethnicity in National Censuses and Surveys**

In an effort to have comparable information across countries, the IDB has worked on harmonizing race and ethnicity variables from censuses and household surveys in the region. This section contains the criteria recommended for defining comparable ethno-racial categories, while explaining the decisions made to address gaps in data availability.

### **3.1. Groups**

Due to the large number of distinct indigenous peoples and African descendant categories both within and across countries, it is necessary to create aggregate categories in order to make comparisons between countries as well as to ensure that sample sizes are statistically significant. However, as previously discussed, identity in Latin America tends to be fluid and there are individuals who self-identify as both indigenous and African descendant or belong to a group that is both indigenous and of African descent (Garifunas being a key example of the latter case, see Box 3).

### Box 3 Garifuna

According to historians, the Garifuna are the descendants of enslaved Africans who were shipwrecked off the coast of St. Vincent in 1635 and the island's indigenous Carib peoples (Post Rust, 2001). The Garifuna coexisted with French settlers who arrived in the area later in the 17th century. However, tensions arose when English colonists arrived. These tensions eventually turned to a war the Garifuna and French lost in 1796 to the English. The English imprisoned the Garifuna and exiled them to the island of Baliceaux. Survivors were shipped to Roatán Island off the coast of Honduras. They later established fishing villages in Honduras, Nicaragua, Guatemala, and Belize (Rivas, 2000).

Based on their ethno-racial origin and distinct language, the Garifuna people are considered indigenous and are internationally recognized as such. However, the Garifuna are phenotypically African descendant as they are the descendants of enslaved Africans. Under Guatemalan law, the Garifuna have officially been granted the status of indigenous peoples since 1995 (*Acuerdo Sobre Identidad y Derechos de los Pueblos Indígenas*, March 15, 1995), and appear as a distinct category in the surveys (see Annex 4.2). Therefore, in order to enable harmonization across countries, we define the Garifuna population as Afro-indigenous in all countries, including them as indigenous in the indigenous variable and as African descendants in the African descendant variable. Garifunas are also included in the Afro-indigenous category of our categorical variable.

Due to these challenges, we propose the use of three distinct variables for race/ethnicity. The first two are binary variables for indigenous peoples and African descendants: one for those who consider themselves indigenous and all those who do not, and one for African descendant individuals and all non-African descendants. The third variable is categorical and includes four different groups: indigenous peoples, African descendants, Afro-indigenous (those who identify as both African descendant and indigenous or as members of groups such as the Garifuna), and one for all other ethno-racial groups. It is important to remember to use the categorical variable when determining the total African descendant and indigenous populations so as not to double count Afro-indigenous peoples. It is also important to note that the sum of the indigenous and African descendant population defined using the binary variables will be equal to the sum of those groups minus Afro-indigenous in the third variable, for all countries except Uruguay, where individuals are allowed multiple identities.<sup>12</sup> For more information on the exact definitions of the variables for all the census and surveys analyzed, please refer to Annex 4.2.

The binary variables are built based on whether people consider themselves to have any afro or indigenous ascendance, while the categorical variable is built using the respondents' primary identity. ## 3.2. Missing Information

In some countries, questions on ethno-racial identity are not asked of all individuals. In Peru, for example, the ENAHO survey includes ethno-racial identity within the labor market modules, which only survey individuals over the age of 14.<sup>13</sup> Similarly, in El Salvador, the ethnicity question is asked only to people over the age of 18, while in Mexico, children's ethno-racial identity is not identified by respondents unless they are over 3 years old. This means that a substantial portion of individuals do not have an ethno-racial identity in the data.

To solve these issues as well as to have a more complete portrait of the conditions faced by different ethno-racial groups, the ethno-racial identity of the head of household should be applied in the place of missing values for familial relations who were not asked the question. This is applicable for direct relatives such as children, nieces, nephews, and grandchildren who are under the age that the question is asked. However, imputing the head of household race for non-direct relatives, such as in-laws is not advisable.<sup>14</sup>

<sup>14</sup> In Argentina's 2001 census, the question on ethnicity was asked only at the household level, and is worded in such a manner that it is impossible to know which household member is indigenous. In order to have any degree of comparability with the next census round and because the two censuses are the only sources of information on ethnicity in the country, it was decided to impute the answer to this question to all members of the household. As such, for the 2001 Argentine Census if the respondent is indigenous, all the individuals in that household are considered indigenous as well. These are strong assumptions, but allow for analysis at the household level. While this variable will be comparable across household variables, researchers should be careful in the use of these results at the individual level and provide appropriate documentation and caveats where needed.

## 3.3. Household Level Analysis of Race

To analyze household level characteristics and ethno-racial gaps, it is important to have an ethno-racial variable for the household, as the household level unit of analysis is the most used for determining inequality. Therefore, we are relying on the commonly used ethno-racial identity of the household head to allow for comparisons.
