SOME KEY LESSONS AND FINDINGS

Enhancing development effectiveness with corporate evaluations

- » To increase the use of guarantees, the IDB Group must enhance its recognition as a provider
- » The Grant Facility for Haiti evaluation found the need for a comprehensive, fragility-sensitive approach that delivers high-quality projects and development results
- » It is critical to address the heightened information asymmetry generated by delegating responsibilities typical of entities with corporate management and shareholders

ICPRs: Enhancing the Relevance of Country Strategies

- » OVE's Updated Protocol revises the scope, approach, and process of its country products: ICPRs and XCPEs
- » ICPRs completed during 2022: Ecuador, Peru, Chile, Guyana, Jamaica
- » Common findings related to country strategies' objectives, evaluability, relevance and alignment, implementation issues, and contribution

Validation of PCRs and XSRs

- » 2022 cycle
- » 62 PCRs, of which about half (53%) of the Sovereign-Guarantee validated operations achieved a positive overall outcome rating
- » 47 XSRs, of which 57% did so on the Non-Sovereign-Guarantee side

Main Lessons

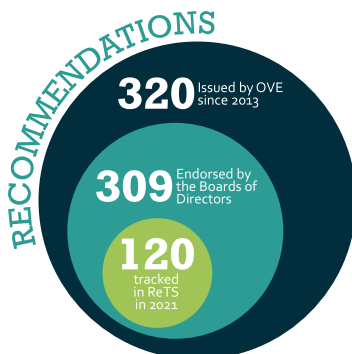
- » Completeness and candor are essential for quality self-evaluation
- » Close collaboration between Management and OVE is key to establishing a common approach for self-evaluation

Evaluation capacity development (ECD): Fulfilling OVE's Mandate in the LAC Region

- » OVE supported Guatemala's national monitoring and evaluation system
- » Worked closely with the Global Evaluation Initiative (GEI) in the design of its LAC strategy
- » Helped consolidate ReDeCa, the Brazilian evaluation network of development banks

The Recommendation Tracking System (ReTS)

OVE validated management actions to address 120 active recommendations from 29 evaluations
